- The committee identified the following criteria to guide their final prioritization:
 - The policy must focus on reducing disparities
 - The policy should add value (i.e., focus on areas not considered by others)
 - There should be evidence to support the policy's effectiveness
 - The state should have authority/jurisdiction over the policy area
- The committee chose the following four policies:
 - Access to grocery stores
 - School nutritional standards
 - School physical education
 - Corner store initiative
- The group worked on crafting more specific language for the top priorities.
