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

Washington Tracking Network

- How do we identify areas of the state where many of these determinants of poor health exist at once?

Leverage Existing Data Infrastructure

- CDC – Funds the tracking network and receives Washington state data
- CHAT/WSCR – Washington databases built with CDC tracking funding
- WTN – Public portal for displaying data
- IBL – Public facing new way to display WTN data

*Always the most current dataset

*Data will be updated all at once, once a year

Objectives

- Transform data into information
- Make it easy to understand
- Display data at the neighborhood level
- Increase public health relevance of content
- Present data associated with health disparities in a community, NOT to diagnose a health issue or label a community
